

CLAS101 – Classroom Experience

Faculty will have 35-40 minutes to provide a group of students with a classroom experience. Faculty can develop the class as they wish, including lecture, small group discussion, writing, or short presentations.

Faculty will have pencils and paper should you choose to have students do some writing. If faculty want any materials copied, please email Steve (sviveiros@bridgew.edu) with the material and it will be in your specific Advising 101 folder when you pick it up at the AAC.

Students will be divided by major grouping so you can feel free to cover a topic from your particular discipline.

Consider tapping into the Orientation Leader staff as small group facilitators or model students. They are ready and willing to assist.

Options for CLAS101 Experience:

- The writing prompt is one alternative for use in CLAS101. It provides some evidence students can draw on to formulate an answer, and students can obviously bring in their own supporting evidence or ideas.
- Consider having the students reflect on why they are here.
- Start the class with a poem, article or short story.
