Summer 2010 Writing Retreat Application**

Uninterrupted time to write. Space for writing, away from household and office distractions. A supportive writing group. This retreat may be just what you need to make important headway on a project before the new academic year begins.

To participate in the program, write a one-page application that includes the following information:

1. Your name, position, and department
2. A description of your project and project status (i.e., early planning, drafting, ready for feedback, etc.)
3. A description of how the Writing Retreat would help you move forward with your project
4. A description of your goals for the five-day Retreat
5. The intended audience for your project (i.e. which conference, publisher, etc) and your timeline
6. A description of your writing process (where, when, and how you usually write)
7. A statement that verifies that, should your application be accepted, you would be able to commit to participating from 8:30-5:00 on August 23 – 27, 2010.
