The Heart of Echizen: Wood Fired Works by Contemporary Masters

An exhibition that showcases the contributions that Echizen's contemporary ceramic artists have made to the cultural legacy of Japanese aesthetics. This exhibition includes works by eleven of the city's finest contemporary master potters who use the traditional Anagama (wood kiln) to fire their work. Echizen, Japan, is home to one of the oldest of six medieval ceramic kiln sites in operation today and to approximated sixty contemporary ceramic potters.
